- Uniforms were ordered this past month so any new registration requests are being turned away.
- Opening Day – We had a bit of rain but we were able to have a decent turn-out. We made approximately \$1,400 from the weekend. Uniforms were distributed the week prior and only had a couple of issues, mainly pants or hats. Game Balls were also distributed accordingly.
- TBall Draft conducted right before board meeting. Rosters to be created and emailed out to coaches. There are 6 teams.
- Recreation Update – Coaches need to not remove pitching rubbers. Please be mindful of seeds, gum and wrappers. Digging at pitching mounds and batter boxes are excessive.

- Box of Pants added to Lock-up. These were some extras that Deb had, mostly of the older belt style pants.
- Memorial Tournament – Brackets will be set by the Wednesday Prior to the tournament. Propane will be needed. Team/Player Awards have been received. We have 6 Minor, 12 Major, and 6 Pony teams playing this year.

Open Forum:

- Concerns were brought up about the Major field Pitcher landing area.
- Minor Coach Latini expressed concerns about his team playing the Willoughby Hills 2 (Dugout Travel) team on 6/11 and that they would forfeit the game if it was necessary to play. Discussion about WH allowing a Travel team to play as a city rec team.
- Concerns brought up about the Pitching Rubber Distance in other cities. Teams checked distance and it was not corrected mid-game. Teams were not certain how to address this should it come up in their games.
- Coaches have not been seeing scores reported for games played.
- Some of the lock boxes have been difficult to unlock. They often require several tries to open but generally the keys do work. We will have to monitor this and decide to replace if necessary.
